

Mike Davis Bursary Fund

The 'Mike Davis Bursary Fund' was launched in 2017 when Mike stepped down as ALSG's lead educator after a hugely successful 21 years in post. In honour of Mike's contribution to ALSG, this special fund was launched to give future ALSG UK instructors the opportunity to complete a GIC where they may not have the financial support to do so.

Mike has been involved with ALSG since 1996 when a chance meeting led to him getting involved in the life support community as an educator on the GIC, which he continued to do for 21 years. He has also been an educator with ATLS, ETC, IMPACT and the Child Protection Masterclass/Facilitation course in the UK and overseas.

ALSG would like to thank Mike for his steadfast support over the last 21 years and we hope by launching this UK Bursary Fund in his name, it will give our future instructors the opportunity Mike worked so hard to deliver on our courses.

Applications

The Mike Davis Bursary Fund has been set up in recognition of Mike's loyal support of ALSG over the last 21 years. It is aimed at UK healthcare professionals who have been recommended to do a GIC but lack the financial support of employers to be able to do so.

The Bursary annually awards one funded GIC place at ALSG, Manchester, to a potential UK ALSG instructor based on an application made from January 2026 to the 31st March 2026. Applications received before the closing date will be considered for one GIC place, offered within 12 months after the closing date. All applications will be assessed by an independent committee from ALSG including: Dr Mike Davis, Dr Kate Denning (Director of Education & Development, ALSG) and Stephanie Smith (ALSG Chair of Trustees).
